You have recently been advised of the availability of SPOUSE AND/OR DEPENDENT CHILDREN coverage of TRAVEL ACCIDENT LIFE INSURANCE. The purpose of this Bulletin is to establish the procedures for entering the deduction on the Payroll Voucher.


The entry on the Payroll Voucher will be made in column 54 STATE LIFE DED. AMT. This amount will be added to the amount deducted for STATE LIFE DED. AMT. Only one entry will be made in this column, that being the total amount of the premium for STATE LIFE DED. AMT. and TRAVEL ACCIDENT LIFE INSURANCE SPOUSE AND/OR DEPENDENT CHILDREN.

The coding in column 53 will not be affected in any way.

The first deduction will be made for Payrolls covering January 1 to 15.
