SUBJECT: State Sponsored Health Insurance

Beginning with any pay period beginning after June 30, 1986, the State's basic health plan provider, now Blue Cross, which is coded D1, will change to Equitable, code D3. All employee records with D1 should be changed to D3 if the employee stays with the basic health plan. Payrolls submitted with a pay period ending date prior to July 1, 1986, should continue to use D1 if the employee had Blue Cross coverage.

Beginning with any pay period ending after June 30, 1986, there will be only one trailer record to represent deductions for all State sponsored health insurance. This includes the State's basic health carrier and the HMOs. For all monies shown in column 58 of the payroll voucher, the trailer record number must be 30 OD2 and the payee must be Health Insurance Reserve Fund. The detail employee coverage codes shown in column 57 of the voucher will be those provided by the Department of Central Management Services.

For payrolls with a pay period ending date prior to July 1, 1986, you should continue to make the trailer records payable to the appropriate carriers as you are now doing.
