SUBJECT: Illinois State Income Tax Exemptions - 2022

The Illinois Department of Revenue has released [Booklet IL-700-T](#) for 2022. Illinois withholding information and tax tables effective January 1, 2022, are presented in this publication. The State of Illinois individual income tax rate remains at 4.95%, but the state income tax exemptions have changed from \$2,375 to \$2,425 for the 2022 tax year. The exemption amounts per pay frequency are provided below. This change is effective for the December 16-31, 2021, pay period.

## 2021 State Tax Exemptions

Bi-weekly	\$93.27
Semi-monthly	\$101.04
Monthly	\$202.08
